### PROJECTS - Cudham Marriage Register 1837-1900

Cudham is a village in the London Borough of Bromley and we are **still seeking volunteers** to transcribe the hand written register entries for these marriages on to a standard spreadsheet. The next stage in this process is to check the work of the transcribers so the record details can be processed for publication so **volunteer checkers** would also be welcome.

There is also an educational reward for the volunteer translaters as it gives an insight into the background of BMD records and how they are formed. This helps to make better informed choices when you are faced with a choice of commercial records for your ancestors.

#### Talk: 'Early and Quirky Brixton' by Chris Burton

Chris is a qualified Camden & Islington Walking Tour Guide who leads walks and talks based on the theme 'first and quirky'. On this occasion she has turned her attention south of the River.
